Milwaukee Folding Carton (a division of Rock Tenn) recently installed an electronic text verification system (SCAN-TVS™) that is now up and running. Ramp-up and integration were not without issue, but Global Vision, the manufacturer, provided prompt technical support for the system, and the plant is moving to full usage. Fourteen employees have been trained on the new system, and all are involved in various aspects of usage. The system is the first installation in the United States using a 50-inch scanner.

The SCAN-TVS™ provides many time and cost-saving advantages. For example, the system can scan and save proofs in two to three minutes and can copy-check rooftop-press sheets in only 11 minutes. In addition, the Global Vision TVS™2.0 software is user-friendly, and the computer is well integrated with the software and the scanner.

Bob Gehrke, print manager, and Darrin Rinwolski, training facilitator, are working with the TVS. group to improve the time to scan a sheet. The TVS electronic proofreading technology is used by the Printing and Quality Assurance departments to scan printed sheets and verify copy to proof. Modifications to the hardware, training and procedures have helped this system to become a seamless part of the operation.

The system is already reducing scan times on copy verification for full press sheets. "We are very excited about this new technology and are looking forward to sharing it with the rest of the Company", said Gary Adreon, General Manager.
